The organizations listed below offer scholarships and financial assistance to families sending their children to a private school – **please note that Olney Christian School has no affiliation with any of these foundations.**

The following organizations require you to be a **Pennsylvania Resident** and also meet certain income guidelines.

- ***Children’s Scholarship Fund- Philadelphia, PA***

 - This Scholarship offers four-year K-8th grade scholarships to low-income families in Philadelphia. Scholarships are awarded by a lottery system. Recipients receive up to \$2,800 towards tuition. The application is three simple qualifying questions. You can apply online at:
- ***Family Choice Scholarship***

 - This Scholarship is a project of the Pennsylvania Family Institute. They are committed to assisting families in sending students to the school of their choice. In previous years, they have given one time scholarship awards in the amount of \$300 to \$1,000. There is a \$25 application fee. Applications are accepted until early July.
- ***The Bravo Foundation***

 - Every year in June the Bravo Foundation holds a drawing, where it selects schools to win scholarship funding. If we are selected, we will send out the link for the scholarship application.

 - CEO|America awards scholarships to students going into grades 2 to 8 and who are transferring from a public school to private school like Olney Christian. They make awards up to \$3,500 for two years.
